

C&O Canal Lockhouse Living Tour – A Venture into the 1920’s and Before

Experience the C&O Canal history like no one else and live like a lock tender for a few nights, on Get Out & Go Tours’ newest, and most exclusive tour. Enjoy all the scenery and highlights of the trail in the spring, or summer, and spend two nights in two different Park lockhouses on our three-day-weekend “lockhouse living” tour!



Day 1: Shuttle from DC to Paw Paw, WV. Ride up to 48 miles from Paw Paw, WV (mile 156.25) through the Paw Paw tunnel, and on to Four Locks (mile 108.8), where we will over-night in Lockhouse 49. Enroute, you might take optional side trips into Hancock, MD (mile 124.5), to Fort Frederick (mile 112), or explore the remnants of the town of Four Locks around the lockhouse. Enjoy a picnic style lunch at Little Orleans (mile 140) and a cooked Italian dinner at the lockhouse, with drinks and snacks provided. The lockhouse has electricity and a port-a-potty, with a seasonal water pump nearby.



Day 2: After cooked breakfast, continue riding *up to* 60 miles (support vehicle available to shorten mileage), traversing Williamsport (mile 99), then Shepherdstown (mile 72), with optional side trips into a number of the caves along the trail, or through Antietam Battlefield, Harpers Ferry (mile 61), Brunswick (mile 56), Catoctin Aqueduct (mile 50.9) and on to Lockhouse 28 (mile 48.93), where we over-night for a second night. This time, the lockhouse is of an earlier period, with a port-a-potty and without electricity. Picnic style lunch, and a cookout dinner is provided, with drinks and snacks throughout the day.



Day 3: After continental breakfast, continue riding up to 48 miles to Washington DC, enroute passing Monocacy Aqueduct (mile 42), Whites Ferry (mile 35.5), and Great Falls National Park (mile 14), before arriving and exploring the city on your own. Picnic style lunch is provided, with drinks and snacks during the day.

This tour allows you to ride most of the C&O Canal, seeing nearly all of the trail highlights, while experiencing it over-night like no one else can. All linens and blankets, group gear, and lanterns are provided by Get Out & Go Tours. All you need to bring is your riding clothes.
